Assessment of vacancies of Non-Technical Popular categories (NTPC) done by Zonal Railways/PUs in the Indent Management module of HRMS has been examined in Railway Board.

2. The Competent authority (CRB & CEO) has approved to issue Centralized Employment Notification (CEN) for 5817 vacancies in NTPC (Graduate) and 3058 vacancies in NTPC (Under-Graduate) for the year 2025 as given below:

(A) NTPC (Graduate):



3. The Railway/PU-wise distribution of vacancies is given in **Annexure - A** for NTPC (Graduate) and **Annexure-B** for NTPC (Under Graduate). The zonal/PU distribution has taken into consideration the pending inter-railway transfer applications.
4. Immediate action should be taken by Zonal Railways/PUs for placing the final indent (not exceeding vacancies approved by Board) in OIRMS within a period of one week in consultation with Chairman/RRB/Bengaluru. While placing final indent, Railways/PUs must ensure prescribed reservation norms for SC/ST/OBC/EWS etc.
